

The three little pigs were late for school again.


'We were hiding from the big bad wolf,' they said. 'We couldn't run away - we're not fit.'

'Oh dear!' said Mr Grunt. He wrote a report and sent it to Mrs Pig.


This report is to help the three little pigs eat healthier food.
