Babe starts to behave like a sheep dog. The pig helps the farmer win a sheep dog competition. I was really excited when the book was made into a film.

Interviewer: You have written a book about a family of mice and a clever pig. I heard that you even wrote a story about a dog that belongs to the Queen of England. Is that true?

Dick King-Smith: Yes. The queen is famous for loving her dogs. I thought it would be fun to write a story about one of them. My book is called *Titus Rules*. Titus is a very funny dog. I hope my readers will like the story. I always enjoy meeting my readers and asking them what they think of my books. I love children, which is why I also worked as a teacher. After I left teaching, I started writing books for children. Now I sometimes go to schools and read my books to them.

Interviewer: You have written over one hundred books! That's a lot of books! Do you plan to write more?

Dick King-Smith: Yes, I think so. I am 88 years old now but I still like to keep busy. As long as children keep reading my books, I will keep writing them. I have been a soldier, a farmer and a teacher, but most of all I love being a writer.
